The District's Board declares that the District will observe the following official holidays:

Independence Day (July 4th)
Labor Day
Patriot Day (September 11th)
Columbus or Indigenous Peoples Day
Veterans Day (November 11th)
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day (December 25th)

If a holiday falls on a Saturday, the holiday will be observed on the preceding Friday and if the holiday falls on a Sunday, then the holiday will be observed on the following Monday.

In accordance with the above official holidays, the District's office will be closed to the public and the District's Board of will not meet.

The Secretary shall ensure the above official holidays are considered when posting public notices requiring advance notice.
