

Rule

The Chair of the District's Board of Directors, with input from other Directors and staff, may place matters on a Consent Calendar which shall be taken up at meetings near the beginning of the meeting.

The Consent Calendar shall be represented by matters in italicized font on the meeting agendas of the District's Board of Directors.

When matters on the Consent Calendar are called up, the matters shall be considered in whole, without debate, and without amendment. Any Director may remove a matter from the Consent Calendar to have it considered under the rules just as any other business.
