## Rule

By law, each member of a fire protection district's board of directors may receive an attendance fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) for attending each regularly called board meeting, or special meeting, but shall not be paid for attending more than two in any calendar month.

The attendance fee for each member of the District's Board shall be $\qquad$ dollars (\$ $\qquad$ ) per meeting.

A member of the District's Board shall not receive his or her an attendance fee until the member has submitted a completed Internal Revenue Service Form W-4, a completed Missouri Department of Revenue Form MO W-4, and the member can show proof that all County property taxes are paid, including interest and penalties. A member of the District's Board shall not retroactively receive attendance fees that were not paid due to unpaid County property taxes.

In addition, by law, the Chair of the District's Board may receive fifty dollars (\$50) for attending each regularly or specially called board meeting but shall not be paid the additional fee for attending more than two meetings in any calendar month.

The attendance fee for the Chair of the District's Board shall be $\qquad$ dollars (\$ $\qquad$ ) per meeting.

The Chair of the District's Board shall not receive his or her additional fee until the Chair has submitted a completed Internal Revenue Service Form W-4, a completed Missouri Department of Revenue Form MO W-4, and the Chair can show proof that all County property taxes are paid, including interest and penalties. The Chair of the District's Board shall not retroactively receive additional fees that were not paid due to unpaid County property taxes.
