Rule

Filling Director vacancies must be in accordance with Missouri Law.

Vacancies may be filled by appointment by elected Directors of the current Board of Directors or left vacant until the April election in an odd year. That is, appointed Directors cannot appoint to fill a vacancy on the Board and elections for Directors are never held in even years for the District.

Vacancies will be filled by the Circuit Court if there is only one elected Director on the District's Board

If a vacancy is filled in time to publish a notice of candidate filing in November or very early December of an even year, then a Director appointed to fill a vacancy may only serve until the next April election in an odd year.

If a vacancy is filled without enough time to publish a notice of candidate filing in November or very early December of an even year, then a Director appointed to fill a vacancy may only serve until the next April election in the second odd year after such vacancy is filled.

Example: A vacancy is filled in mid-December 2022. The appointed Director may serve until April 2025 because it was too late to hold an April 2023 election to fill the remainder of any term of the vacancy.
